Resolution adopted during the 71st plenary meeting on 26 September 1962

ACTION PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 891 (XXXIV) OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL OF THE UNITED NATIONS

The General Conference,

- (a) Noting with satisfaction Resolution 891 (XXXIV) of the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations which, inter alia, invites the Secretary-General of the United Nations "to continue to keep under review, in co-operation with the regional economic commissions and with the related agencies concerned, the basic aspects of economic and social consequences of disarmament and the problems arising therefrom on the national and international plane", and
- (b) Conscious of the positive consequences of disarmament on the development of peaceful uses of atomic energy,

Requests the Director General to give full co-operation to the Secretary-General of the United Nations in the fulfilment of the task entrusted to him, and to inform the Board of Governors, as well as the General Conference at its seventh regular session, of the steps taken.
