I. Takos note of the oxtonsion of tho igency's sefoguards systom to largo roactor facilities provisionally approvod by the Board of Govornors and containod in dncumont GC(VII)/235;
2. Invitos tho Board, beforo giving cffect to this document, to take into account the viows oxprossod in the Genoral Conforonco and tho proposod amondmonts containcd in document GC(VII)/COM. $2 / 34 ;$
