EXTENSION OF THE AGENCY'S SAFEGUARDS SYSTEM

Resolution adopted during the 80th plenary meeting on 30 September 1963

EXTENSION OF THE AGENCY'S SAFEGUARDS SYSTEM

The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling Articles III.A.5 and XII of the Agency's Statute,
 - (b) Bearing in mind that the procedures previously approved for the application of safeguards by the Agency relate only to reactors up to 100 thermal megawatts,
 - (c) Noting that the Board of Governors has provisionally approved provisions designed to extend the Agency's safeguards system to provide for application to reactors over 100 thermal megawatts, and
 - (d) Noting also that the Board has decided to undertake in 1964 the general review of the Agency's safeguards system envisaged in paragraph 5 of document INFCIRC/26, giving particular attention to the provisions relating to the attachment of safeguards to equipment,
1. Takes note of the extension of the Agency's safeguards system to large reactor facilities provisionally approved by the Board of Governors and contained in document GC(VII)/235;
 2. Invites the Board, before giving effect to this document, to take into account the views expressed in the General Conference and the proposed amendments contained in document GC(VII)/COM.2/34;

3. Requests the Director General, for this purpose, to transmit to the Board the records of the discussions at the seventh regular session of the General Conference on this document;
4. Invites the Board to include in its annual reports to the General Conference an account of the application of this extension; and
5. Further invites the Board to report to the General Conference on the results of its general review of the Agency's safeguards system as envisaged in paragraph 5 of document INFCIRC/26.
