CO-ORDINATION OF ATOMIC ENERGY ACTIVITIES

The General Conference,

1. <u>Takes note</u> of Resolution 986(XXXVI) on co-ordination of atomic energy activities adopted by the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations (ECOSCC) at its thirty-sixth session, and in particular of the affirmation by ECOSOC that the Agency

"should act as the primary sponsor, in co-operation, where appropriate, with the interested specialized agencies, of activities in which atomic energy or research relating thereto forms the major part of the subject matter".

2. <u>Affirms</u> the Agency's readiness in accordance with the ECOSOC resolution to co-operate fully with the United Nations and the specialized agencies in seeking more effective co-ordination;

3. <u>Requests</u> the Board of Governors and the Director General to take such further steps as may be necessary to ensure co-ordination at the earliest possible stage in the development of Agency programmes and rrojects; and

4. <u>Requests</u> the Director General to circulate the text of the ECOSOC resolution to all Member States.
