INTRODUCTION OF BIENNIAL PROGRAMMING

The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling its Resolution GC(VI)/RES/120 regarding biennial programming within the framework of annual budgets,
- (b) Bearing in mind the invitation it has addressed to the Board of Governors and the Director General to take the long-term programme for the Agency's activities $\frac{1}{}$ as a guide in planning and executing the Agency's work over the years, beginning in $1965\frac{2}{}$,
- (c) <u>Considering</u> that 1965 will also be the first year of the next biennial period under the United Nations Expanded Programme of Technical Assistance,

<u>Invites</u> the Board of Governors and the Director General to take steps to implement the proposal for biennial programming within the framework of annual budgets, beginning in 1965.
