THE AGENCY'S RELATIONS WITH INTERCOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS

Resolution adopted during the 90th plenary meeting on 18 September 1964

CO-OPERATION BETWEEN THE AGENCY AND THE SCIENTIFIC, TECHNICAL AND RESEARCH COMMISSION OF THE ORGANISATION FOR AFRICAN UNITY

The General Conference,

- (a) <u>Recalling</u> that a scientific commission whose main purpose is to further science and technology has been set up under the Charter of the Organisation for African Unity,
- (b) Noting that the scientific, technical and research activities of this commission are closely related to those of the Agency,
- (c) <u>Believing</u> that co-operation between the Agency and the Organisation for African Unity will contribute towards the wider utilization of atomic energy for the benefit of African countries, and
- (d) <u>Having noted</u> that Article XVI.A of the Statute stipulates that the Board of Governors, with the approval of the General Conference, is authorized to enter into an agreement or agreements establishing an appropriate relation—ship between the Agency and the United Nations and any other organizations the work of which is related to that of the Agency,

Recommends that the Board of Governors take the requisite steps to enable the Agency to conclude, in the near future, an agreement with the Scientific, Technical and Research Commission of the Organisation for African Unity establishing close collaboration between the Agency and the Organisation.
