c/ This pledge is subject to increase. The United States of America will contribute an amount equal to 35% of all contributions to the General Fund for 1968 that are paid by the end of 1969, up to a percentage of the target equal to its percentage assessment under the Regular Budget for 1968.

d/ 90% of this sum is pledged in local currency.

2. When the Conference takes up this item of its agenda the President will invite its attention to the contributions to the **General Fund** for next year that have by then been pledged. In order to expedite matters, the delegates of those Members that have not yet pledged a contribution are accordingly invited to communicate their Governments' pledges as soon as possible to Mr. P.
