ELECTION OF MEMBERS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS
Memorandum by the Director General

1. Under Rule 86 of the Rules of Procedure ${ }^{1 /}$ the General Cormittee is called upon to determine the number of elective places on the Board of Governors which must be filled by the General Conference, as well as to specify each geographical area in respect of which a Member or Menbers must be elected so as to ensure compliance with the provisions of Article VI.A. 3 of the Statute.
2. Of the present Members elected at previous sessions, the terms of office of five - Brazil, Chile, the Netherlands, the Syrian Arab Republic and Thailand - will expire at the end of the sixteenth regular session. The committee will, therefore, no doubt wish to determine and so report to the Conference that five Members must be elected to the Board during this session.
3. Article VI.A. 3 of the Statute provides that the 12 Members of the Board elected by the Conference shall always include:

3 from Latin America,<br>1 from Western Europe,<br>1 from Eastern Europe,<br>3 from Africa and the Middle East,<br>1 from South Asia,<br>1 fram South East Asia and the Pacific, and<br>1 from the Far East.

Since the seven elected Members that will continue to serve on the Board after the end of the current session are China, Colombia, the Arab Republic of Egypt, Greece, Romania, the Republic of Sri Lanka and the Republic of Zaire2/, the Cormittee will doubtless wish to specify that the following elections are required in respect of geographical areas:

2 from Latin America,
1 from Africa and the Midale East, and
1 from South East Asia and the Pacific.

Peport of the General Comaittee

1. Wule 86 of the Rules of procedure $1 /$ requires the ceneral Conference to cietramine the nunber of elective places on the Board of Covemors which must be filled by the General Conference so as to ensure compliance with the provisions of Article VI.A. 3 of the Statute. The Comittee accordingly notifjes the Conference that it has decemined that five Members must be elected to the Board during the present session. In this connection, the Comnittee invites attention to the last provision in the Article, which stipulates that
".... no member in the category lof menbers elected to the Board by the Genaral Conferencel in any one term of office shall be eligible for reelection in the sance category for the following term of office."2/
2. Rule 86 further requires the General Comittee to specify the geographical areas in respect of which a Menber or Menbers must be elected so as to ensure that after the end of che gession the Board shall include three Members each alected by the Conference from the areas of Iatin Anerica and of Africa and the Middle East, and one Kember from each of the remaining areas, except North Amerisa, specified in Rule a3. In co liance with this rovision, the
 in respect of three geocraphical areas, as follews:

2 Menbers fron Latin America,
1 Merber Erom Arrica and the lidale Fast, and

1 Menber from South East Asia and the Pacific.

The remaining Meriber may be elected from any gexgraphical area in so far as its election is not precluded by the provisions of Article VI of the Statute.
3. In view of the provision in Rule 83 that the Conference shall conduct the elections with due regard to equitable representation on the Board as a whole of the Members in the geographical areas specified in that Rule, it may wish
