The General Conference suspended for the twenty-first regular session the relevant part of Rule 40 of its Rules of Procedure [1] to permit the election of seven additional members. It elected the delegates of Canada, Chile, Egypt, France, Hungary, Sudan and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland as additional Members of the General Committee, and duly appointed the Committee for the twenty-first regular session.
