CONTRIBUTION BY THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN SUPPORT
OF THE AGENCY'S PROGRAMME FOR RESEARCH
AND MEDICAL THERAPY

Note by the Director General

The Representative of the United States of America to the International Atomic Energy Agency informed the Director General, in a letter dated 27 September 1977, of a contribution of nuclear material his Government intends to make in 1978 in support of the Agency's programme for research and medical therapy. At the request of the Resident Representative, the text of his letter is reproduced below for the information of the Conference.

"27 September 1977

"I am pleased to inform you that the United States Government is prepared to donate in 1978, for the 19th consecutive year, up to \$50 000 worth of special nuclear material to sustain the IAEA program for research and medical therapy. In allocating this gift material, parties to the Non-Proliferation Treaty will be given preference, as we have indicated in prior years."
