## ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE CONFEERENCE

(b) closing date of the session and opening date of the next session
1.

The CHAIRMAN recalled that, in accordance with Rule 8 of the Rules of Procedure, the Committee had to make a recommendation to the General Conference concerning the closing date of the session. The general debate would probably continue until the late morming of Monday. Thus, the session could be closed during the afternoon of Monday if the Committee of the Whole had completed its work in time.
2. He took it, therefore, that the Committee authorized him to recomend to the General Conference that it decide to close the session on Monday afternoon.
3. It was so decided.

The CHATRMAN recalled that it was customary for the Committee to present to the General Conference a recommendation concerning the opening date of the next regular session. Traditionally, the General Conference was held during the fourth week of September; in addition, the preference of most delegates was that the session should open on a Monday rather than on a Tuesday. He took it, therefore, that the Committee authorized him to recomend to the General Conference to decide that Monday, 22 September 1980 should be the opening date of the twenty-fourth regular session, which was to be held in Vienna.
5. It was so decided.
