Resolution adopted during the 228th plenary meeting on 21 September 1981

APPLICATION BY ZIMBABWE FOR MEMBERSHIP OF THE AGENCY

The General Conference,

(a) Having received the recommendation of the Board of Governors that Zimbabwe should be approved for membership of the Agency,^{1/} and

(b) Having considered the application of Zimbabwe for membership in the light of Article IV.B of the Statute,

1. Approves Zimbabwe for membership of the Agency; and

2. Determines, pursuant to Financial Regulation 6.08^{2/}, that in the event of Zimbabwe becoming a Member of the Agency during the remainder of 1981 or in 1982, it shall be assessed as appropriate:

(a) For an advance or advances to the Working Capital Fund, in accordance with Financial Regulation 7.03^{3/}; and

(b) For a contribution or contributions towards the Agency's administrative expenses, in accordance with the revised arrangements for the assessment of Members for such contributions^{4/}.
