The General Conference suspended for the twenty-sixth regular session the relevant part of Rule 40 of its Rules of Procedure to permit the election of six additional Members. It elected the delegates of Bolivia, France the German Democratic Republic, Saudi Arabia, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and Zambia as additional members of the General Committee, and duly appointed the General Committee for the twenty-sixth regular session.
