Resolution adopted during the 256th plenary meeting on 14 October 1983

THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION ON THE PHYSICAL PROTECTION OF NUCLEAR MATERIAL

The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling the resolutions adopted at its nineteenth and twenty-first regular sessions regarding the physical protection of nuclear materials,[1]
- (b) $\underline{\text{Recalling}}$ the adoption in October 1979 of the Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material, and
- (c) Noting that to date there are 37 signatories and eight ratifications of the Convention,
- 1. Expresses the hope that the Convention will enter into force at the earliest possible date and that it will obtain the widest possible adherence; and
- 2. Requests the Director General to report to the General Conference at its next regular session on the signature and ratification status of the Convention.
