Resolution adopted during the 268th plenary meeting on 28 September 1984

REVIEW OF THE AGENCY'S ACTIVITIES

The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling its resolution GC(XXVI)/RES/399, whereby it requested the Board of Governors, in consultation with the Director General, "to conduct a review of the Agency's activities over the past 25 years to study the best ways and means to respond to the growing needs of the developing countries in the peaceful uses of atomic energy",
 - (b) Recalling its resolution GC(XXVII)/RES/421, whereby it took note of the progress report by the Board of Governors contained in document GC(XXVII)/698 and requested the Board "to submit its report on the matter to the General Conference at its twenty-eighth session",
 - (c) Considering the Board's report "Review of the Agency's activities" contained in document GC(XXVIII)/718 and,
 - (d) Mindful of the developing countries' increasing interest in and need for the Agency's activities and programmes related to the peaceful uses of atomic energy,
1. Takes note with appreciation of the Board's report "Review of the Agency's activities";
 2. Notes the special importance for developing countries of the Agency's activities, and particularly those in the field of technical assistance and co-operation and the Agency's other promotional activities;
 3. Calls upon all countries which are in a position to do so to finance as many footnote a/ projects as possible to make them operational;

4. Requests the Board of Governors and the Director General to reflect the findings of the Review in the future programmes of the Agency;
5. Requests the Director General, in accordance with Article XI of the Statute, to provide, upon request, assistance in securing financing from outside sources for nuclear power projects in developing countries, and in particular the least developed countries; and
6. Further requests the Director General to keep the Board and the General Conference informed, through the Agency's Annual Reports, regarding actions taken on this resolution.
