

The General Conference,

(a) Recalling its resolution GC(XXVIII)/RES/432, whereby it requested the Board of Governors to report to the General Conference at its twenty-ninth regular session on the report of the Joint Inspection Unit on the International Atomic Energy Agency's technical co-operation (document JIU/RES/84/9),

(b) Having considered the report of the Board of Governors on the Joint Inspection Unit's report, both contained in document GC(XXIX)/751,

(c) Noting that several of the recommendations made by the Joint Inspection Unit have already been or are being implemented by the Director General and that there have been expressions both of support for and of reservations about some of the other recommendations, and

(d) Mindful of the importance of technical co-operation as one of the main activities of the Agency,

1. Takes note of the report of the Joint Inspection Unit and of the report by the Board of Governors thereon;
2. Expresses its appreciation for the work done by the Joint Inspection Unit in producing its report; and
3. Welcomes the steps that have already been taken and are being taken by the Director General with a view to implementing several of the recommendations made by the Joint Inspection Unit in its report.
