

The General Conference,

Applying the principles it has established for the assessment of Members' contributions towards the Agency's Regular Budget[1],

1. Decides that Members' individual base rates and assessments in respect of the Agency's Regular Budget for 1986 shall be as set forth in the Annex hereto; and
2. Determines, pursuant to Financial Regulation 6.08[2], that in the event of a State becoming a Member of the Agency during the remainder of 1985 or in 1986 it shall be assessed as appropriate:
  - (a) For an advance or advances to the Working Capital Fund, in accordance with Financial Regulation 7.03[3]; and
  - (b) For a contribution or contributions towards the Agency's Regular Budget, in accordance with the principles the Conference has established for that purpose.

STAFFING OF THE AGENCY'S SECRETARIAT

The General Conference,

(a) Taking note with appreciation of the report submitted by the Director General (document GC(XXIX)/755) on the implementation of General Conference resolution GC(XXV)/RES/386,

(b) Taking into account resolution GC(XXVIII)/RES/437 adopted by the General Conference at its twenty-eighth regular session,

(c) Considering that the representation of developing countries, particularly at the senior and policy-making levels, in the Agency's Secretariat remains inadequate,

(d) Convinced that further steps are required to rectify the existing imbalance, and

(e) Convinced also that the implementation of this resolution does not affect the representation of any particular area,

1. Commends the efforts of the Director General and the steps he has taken to increase the number of staff members drawn from developing countries in accordance with General Conference resolution GC(XXV)/RES/386;

2. Requests the Director General in keeping with the Statute to take further specific steps to increase adequately the number of staff members at all levels drawn from developing countries, particularly at the senior and policy-making levels, in the course of the next four years; and

3. Requests the Director General to report annually on the continuing implementation of General Conference resolution GC(XXV)/RES/386 to the Board of Governors and to the General Conference.
