THE AGENCY'S INCIDENT REPORTING SYSTEM

Draft Resolution submitted by Italy

The General Conference,

(a) Taking note of the expanded nuclear safety activities of the Agency, and

(b) Believing that the Agency's Incident Reporting System could, with suitable modifications, make a more important contribution so enhancing the safety of nuclear installations,

1. Requests the Director General to review the types of safety-significant event which each Member State should communicate to the Agency for each type of reactor;
2. Further requests the Director General to consider enlarging the System so that it also covers - inter alia - research reactors, transportation, waste treatment and disposal plants, and other facilities of the nuclear fuel cycle;
3. Invites all Member States to participate in the System and to communicate to the Agency all relevant information on safety-significant events as early as possible and at the latest within one month from the occurrence of the event; and
4. Requests the Director General to set up a group of experts from Member States to study and evaluate safety-significant events.
