MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN INTERNATIONAL CO-OPERATION IN NUCLEAR SAFETY AND RADIOLOGICAL PROTECTION

The General Conference,

- (a) <u>Recalling</u> resolution GC(SPL.I)/RES/2 adopted by it last year at its special session and resolution GC(XXX)/RES/461 adopted at its thirtieth regular session,
- (b) <u>Recalling also</u> the requests made by it at its thirtieth regular session to the Director General concerning the Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material, the Convention on Early Notification of a Nuclear Accident and the Convention on Assistance in the Case of a Nuclear Accident or Radiological Emergency,
- (c) <u>Recalling further</u> the request made by it at its thirtieth regular session to the Director General concerning work under way within the Secretariat in the area of intervention dose levels,
- (d) Taking note of the report by the Board of Governors and the Director General contained in document GC(XXXI)/816 and prepared in response to resolution GC(SPL.I)/RES/2 and to the above—mentioned requests, and
- (e) <u>Bearing in mind</u> the long-term nature of the activities arising out of some of the statements and proposals made during its special session last year,

- 1. <u>Expresses its appreciation</u> of the work done by the Board of Governors and the Secretariat since its thirtieth regular session as reflected in document GC(XXXI)/816 and the relevant summary records of the Board's deliberations in December 1986 and February, June and September 1987;
- 2. <u>Requests</u> the Board and the Secretariat to continue with the activities already initiated and to report on progress at the Conference's thirty-second regular session;
- 3. <u>Requests</u> the Board to build on the experience already gained and continue to pursue initiatives proposed by Member States in the area of nuclear safety and radiological protection;
- 4. <u>Requests</u> the Board to involve all interested Member States in the work which it will be undertaking pursuant to this resolution; and
- 5. Requests the Director General to transmit to the Board the summary records of the discussions in the Committee of the Whole and in the Conference's plenary meetings under the item "Measures to strengthen international co-operation in nuclear safety and radiological protection" together with supporting documentation in the form of draft resolutions submitted and resolutions adopted under this item at the Conference's thirtieth regular session.
