## LETTER TO THE DIRECTOR GENERAL FROM THE RESIDENT REPRESENTATIVE OF ISRAEL

The text of a letter dated 8 September 1988 from the Resident Representative of Israel to the Director General is reproduced below at the Resident Representative's request.

"I have been instructed to inform you that Yom Kippur (the Day of Atonement), the holiest of the Jewish holidays, falls on Wednesday, 21 September 1988.

"I wish to inform you that the Israeli delegation will be absent from all General Conference meetings on this day.

"The Israel delegation requests that subjects pertaining directly to Israel not be discussed during this day.

"I have the honour to request that this letter be circulated to all Member States."
