STAFFING OF THE AGENCY'S SECRETARIAT

The General Conference

- (a) Taking note with appreciation of the report submitted by the Director General (document GC(XXXIII)/885) on the implementation of General Conference resolution GC(XXV)/RES/386,
 - (b) Taking into account resolution GC(XXXII)/RES/500 adopted by the General Conference at its thirty-second regular session,
 - (c) Considering that the representation of developing countries, particularly at the senior and policy-making levels, in the Agency's Secretariat remains inadequate,
 - (d) Convinced that further steps are required to rectify the existing imbalance, and
 - (e) Convinced also that the implementation of this resolution would not affect the due representation of any particular area,
1. Commends the steps taken by the Director General to increase the number of staff members drawn from developing countries in accordance with General Conference resolution GC(XXV)/RES/386;
 2. Requests the Director General in keeping with the Statute to intensify his efforts over a period of four years^{1/} to increase, particularly at the senior and policy-making levels, the number of staff members drawn from developing countries, with due consideration for equitable geographical distribution; and
 3. Requests the Director General to report annually on the continuing implementation of General Conference resolution GC(XXV)/RES/386 to the Board of Governors and the General Conference.
