LETTER TO THE DIRECTOR GENERAL FROM THE RESIDENT REPRESENTATIVE OF ISRAEL

The text of a letter dated 7 September 1990 from the Resident Representative of Israel to the Director General is reproduced below at the Resident Representative's request.

"I have been instructed to inform you that this year Rosh Hashana (the Jewish New Year), which is among the holiest of the Jewish holidays, falls on Thursday and Friday, 20 and 21 September 1990.

"I wish to inform you that the Israel delegation will be absent from all General Conference meetings on those days.

"The Israel delegation requests that subjects pertaining directly to Israel not be discussed during those days.

"I have the honour to request that this letter be circulated to all Member States."  $\overset{\star)}{}$
