ISRAELI NUCLEAR CAPABILITIES AND THREAT

Draft resolution submitted by Egypt, Iraq, Jordan, Ruwait, Lebanon, the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, Morocco, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, the Syrian Arab Republic, Tunisia and the United Arab Emirates

The General Conference,

- (a) Recognizing the urgent need to prevent proliferation of nuclear weapons and nuclear arms race in the area of the Middle East,
- (b) <u>Gravely concerned</u> about Israel's nuclear capability and threat to peace and security in the area,
- (c) Recalling General Conference resolution GC(XXXIV)/RES/526 concerning Israeli nuclear capabilities and threat,
- (d) Recalling Security Council resolution 487/1981, which, inter alia, requested Israel to submit all its nuclear installations to the Agency safeguards system and to refrain from attacking or threatening to attack nuclear installations,
- (e) Alarmed at the continuous refusal by Israel to place all its nuclear installations under the Agency's safeguards, and
- (f) Noting the Director General's report contained in document GC(XXXV)/960,

- 1. <u>Calls once again upon</u> Israel to comply without delay with Security Council resolution 487/1981 by submitting all its nuclear installations to Agency safeguards;
- 2. <u>Urges</u> all the States supplying nuclear materials or equipment to Israel to apply full-scope safeguards to their exports;
- 3. Requests the Director General to consult with Israeli authorities on the implementation of this resolution and to report to the next session of the General Conference;
- 4. <u>Further requests</u> the Director General to inform the Secretary-General of the United Nations of this resolution; and
- 5. <u>Decides</u> to include in the agenda for its thirty-sixth regular session an item entitled "Israeli nuclear capabilities and threat".
