SOUTH AFRICA'S NUCLEAR CAPABILITIES

Draft resolution submitted by Zaire on behalf of the African Group

The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling its resolution GC(XXXIV)/RES/545 on South Africa's nuclear capabilities,
- (b) <u>Stressing</u> that the full disclosure of South Africa's nuclear installations and materials is essential to the peace and security of the region,
- (c) <u>Taking note</u> of document GC(XXXV)/966 indicating accession by South Africa to the Treaty on the Non-proliferation of Nuclear Weapons on 10 July 1991, and
- (d) Further taking note of the fact that the South African Government has negotiated and signed a safeguards agreement with the Agency and committed itself to early and full implementation of the agreement in its statement in the September 1991 session of the Board of Governors,
- 1. Requests the Director General to ensure early implementation of the safeguards agreement;
- 2. Requests the Director General to verify the completeness of the inventory of South Africa's nuclear installations and material and to report to the Board of Governors and the General Conference;
- 3. Also requests the Director General to bring this resolution to the attention of the Secretary-General of the United Nations; and
- 4. <u>Decides</u> to include in the agenda for its thirty-sixth regular session an item entitled "South Africa's nuclear capabilities".
