SOUTH AFRICA'S NUCLEAR CAPABILITIES

Draft resolution submitted by Zaire on behalf of the African Group

The General Conference,

(a) Recalling its resolution GC(XXXIV)/RES/545 on South Africa's nuclear capabilities,

(b) Stressing that the full disclosure of South Africa's nuclear installations and materials is essential to the peace and security of the region,

(c) Taking note of document GC(XXXV)/966 indicating accession by South Africa to the Treaty on the Non-proliferation of Nuclear Weapons on 10 July 1991, and

(d) Further taking note of the fact that the South African Government has negotiated and signed a safeguards agreement with the Agency and committed itself to early and full implementation of the agreement in its statement in the September 1991 session of the Board of Governors,

1. Requests the Director General to ensure early implementation of the safeguards agreement;
2. Requests the Director General to verify the completeness of the inventory of South Africa's nuclear installations and material and to report to the Board of Governors and the General Conference;
3. Also requests the Director General to bring this resolution to the attention of the Secretary-General of the United Nations; and
4. Decides to include in the agenda for its thirty-sixth regular session an item entitled "South Africa's nuclear capabilities".
