STAFFING OF THE AGENCY'S SECRETARIAT

Draft resolution recommended by the Committee of the Whole

The General Conference,

- (a) Taking note with appreciation of the report submitted by the Director General (document GC(XXXV)/968) on the implementation of General Conference resolution GC(XXV)/RES/386,
- (b) Taking into account resolution GC(XXXIV)/RES/541 adopted by the General Conference at its thirty-fourth regular session,
- (c) Considering that the representation of developing countries, particularly at the senior and policy-making levels, in the Agency's Secretariat still remains inadequate,
- (d) Emphasizing that all of the considerations provided for in the Statute for the appointment of staff should be strictly adhered to,
- (e) Convinced that further steps are required to rectify existing imbalances, and
- (f) Convinced also that the implementation of this resolution would not affect the due representation of any particular area,

1. Commends the efforts made by the Director General to increase the number of staff members drawn from developing countries in accordance with General Conference resolution GC(XXV)/RES/386; and
2. Requests the Director General to continue these efforts, in keeping with the provisions of Article VII.D of the Statute, within the period of four years as specified in resolution GC(XXXIII)/RES/521, to achieve this goal and to report annually on the continuing implementation of General Conference resolution GC(XXV)/RES/386 to the Board of Governors and the General Conference, reflecting the percentage of posts held by nationals of all countries, particularly developing countries, both by region and by gender.
