MEASURES TO STRENGTHEN INTERNATIONAL CO-OPERATON IN MATTERS RELATING TO NUCLEAR SAFETY AND RADIOLOGIAL PROTECTION

Resolution adopted during the 341st plenary meeting on 20 September 1991

CONVENTION ON THE PHYSICAL PROTECTION OF NUCLEAR MATERIAL

The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling the resolutions adopted at its nineteenth, twenty-first, twenty-seventh, twenty-eighth, twenty-ninth, thirtieth, thirty-first, thirty-second, thirty-third and thirty-fourth regular sessions regarding the physical protection of nuclear material. 1/,
- (b) <u>Recalling</u> the adoption, in October 1979, of the Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material,
- (c) <u>Noting that</u> to date there are 46 signatories of the Convention and 39 Contracting States and one Contracting Organization,
- (d) Noting that the Convention entered into force in February 1987,
- (e) <u>Noting that</u> all 12 member States of the European Community and the Community itself have now fully adhered to the Convention, and

- (f) <u>Stressing</u> the importance of continued efforts to improve co-operation between Member States parties to the Convention in the implementation of the Convention, and with a view to the preparations for a Review Conference of the Convention to be held in 1992,
- 1. <u>Expresses</u> its appreciation to the Director General for his report on the signature and ratification status and implementation of the Convention²/;
- 2. <u>Continues</u> to express the hope that the Convention will obtain the widest possible adherence;
- 3. <u>Appeals</u> to the States Parties to the Convention which have not already done so to identify and make known to other States Parties, directly or through the Agency, the relevant organizations specified in Article 5.1 of the Convention, identifying the relevant function/competence of each organization;
- 4. Requests the Director General to establish and periodically update a comprehensive list of the central authorities and points of contact referred to in Article 5.1 of the Convention, specifying the relevant competences of these national authorities; and
- 5. <u>Requests</u> the Director General to report to the General Conference at its next regular session on the signature and ratification status of the Convention.
