SOUTH AFRICA'S NUCLEAR CAPABILITIES

Resolution adopted during the 341st plenary meeting on 20 September 1991 SOUTH AFRICA'S NUCLEAR CAPABILITIES

The General Conference,

- (a) Recalling its resolution GC(XXXIV)/RES/545 on South Africa's nuclear capabilities,
- (b) <u>Taking note</u> of document GC(XXXV)/966 indicating accession by South Africa to the Treaty on the Non-proliferation of Nuclear Weapons on 10 July 1991,
- (c) <u>Further taking note</u> of the fact that the South African Government has negotiated and signed a safeguards agreement with the Agency and committed itself to early and full implementation of the agreement in its statement in the September 1991 session of the Board of Governors, and
- (d) <u>Stressing</u> that the full disclosure of South Africa's nuclear installations and materials is essential to the peace and security of the region,
- 1. <u>Requests</u> the Director General to ensure early implementation of the safeguards agreement; and
- 2. <u>Requests</u> the Director General to verify the completeness of the inventory of South Africa's nuclear installations and material and to report to the Board of Governors and to the General Conference at its thirty-sixth regular session.
