HARMONY AND COMPATIBILITY OF PROGRAMME AND BUDGET AND ACCOUNTS DOCUMENTS

## The General Conference,

- (a) <u>Recognizing</u> the importance of the Agency's programme and budget and accounts documents for an objective evaluation of the Agency's activities,
- (b) <u>Noting</u> the External Auditor's comment that "it is difficult to compare planned and actual performance because the presentations [in the programme and budget and the accounts documents] are quite different", and
- (c) <u>Underlining</u> the importance of harmony and compatibility between the Agency's programme and budget and accounts documents for facilitating effective evaluation of the Agency's activities,
- 1. Requests the Director General to ensure that there is harmony and compatibility between the Agency's programme and budget documents, its annual reports and its accounts documents, so as to facilitate their comparison for purposes of effective evaluation;
- 2. Requests the Director General to consult Member States in order to ensure that such Agency documents, transmitted to the General Conference by the Board, are prepared and submitted in accordance with this resolution as early as possible, and at the latest in time for consideration by the General Conference at its thirty-eighth regular session; and
- 3. <u>Further requests</u> the Director General to inform the General Conference at its thirty-seventh regular session about the action taken.
