A. The General Conference acceded to the request by Kazakhstan that the last sentence of Article XIX.A of the Statute be invoked in order that its right to vote in the Agency be restored during the current session of the Conference and until the end of its payment plan on the understanding that Kazakhstan continued to meet the requirements of the payment plan and that the Secretariat would report annually on the status of the payment plan.
