Your Excellency,

I would like to inform you that despite the serious financial difficulties faced by the Government of Georgia over a number of years, the Government remains committed to fulfilling its financial obligations to the IAEA, and in this regard, concluded a ten year Payment Plan Agreement, starting in 2007, to pay off its arrears to the regular budget, as well as a three year Payment Plan Agreement to settle its assessed programme costs arrears.

Under the terms of the Payment Plan Agreement the Government of Georgia has fulfilled its financial obligations for the year 2007 and will continue to meet its financial obligations in the years ahead. On the basis of these commitments and the recent payments, the Government of Georgia requests the restoration of its voting rights at the Agency.
