a/ Cambodia withdrew from the Agency with effect from 26 March 2003 and became a Member again on 23 November 2009.

Payment plan agreement concluded with the Agency in August 2009 and started in 2009.

Cambodia has not made the necessary payments in 2012 and in previous years as requested by the plan.

The minimum amounts required as per the payment plan agreement are €34 555 plus US \$3114.

b/ Payment plan agreement concluded with the Agency in September 2007 and started in 2008. However, the Dominican Republic has not made the necessary payments since 2008, as required by the plan. The minimum amounts required as per the payment plan agreement are €701 630 plus US \$42 395.

c/ Payment plan agreement concluded with the Agency in 2009 and started in 2009. However, Gabon has not made the necessary payments in 2012, as required by the plan. The minimum amounts required as per the payment plan is €9142.
