

SUMMARY OF MEETINGS

held on Wednesday, 18 September 2019

**General
Committee
1st meeting**

The General Committee recommended to the Conference that:

- the agenda for the current session of the General Conference consist of all the items on the provisional agenda set forth in documents GC(63)/1 and Mod.1, with the deletion of item 2 and item 23, and all the supplementary items listed in document GC(63)/1/Add.4;
- the allocation of items for initial discussion listed in documents GC(63)/1 and Mod.1, Add.1, Add.2 and Add.3 be taken up for discussion as indicated in these documents;
- the order of items be as set out in documents GC(63)/1, Mod.1, Add.1, Add.2 and Add.3;
- Friday, 20 September 2019 be set as the closing date of this session; and
- the General Conference start its next regular session on Monday, 21 September 2020.

**Plenary
5th meeting**

The Conference adopted the recommendations of the General Committee and resumed consideration of item 7 of the provisional agenda, “General debate and Annual Report for 2018”. Statements were made by New Zealand, Costa Rica, Thailand, Bulgaria, El Salvador, Chile, Malta, India, Switzerland, Pakistan, Denmark, Spain, Botswana, the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Malaysia, Greece, Paraguay, Turkey, Namibia, the Syrian Arab Republic, Australia, Israel and Portugal.

**Plenary
6th meeting**

The Conference resumed consideration of item 7 of the provisional agenda, “General debate and Annual Report for 2018”. Statements were made by Bosnia and Herzegovina, Uganda, Ecuador, Mongolia, the Republic of Moldova, Singapore, South Africa, Viet Nam, Serbia, Kenya, the Philippines, the Plurinational State of Bolivia, Jamaica, Guatemala, Senegal, the Sudan, Mexico, Kyrgyzstan, Montenegro, Georgia, Myanmar, Mozambique, the Lao People’s Democratic Republic and Afghanistan. The following Member States exercised their rights of reply: the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Russian Federation, Iraq and Ukraine.
