THE TEXT OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY AND MEXICO FOR THE APPLICATION OF SAFEGUARDS UNDER THE TREATY FOR THE PROHIBITION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS IN LATIN AMERICA

Suspension of the application of safeguards

- 1. The application of safeguards under the Agency's agreement with Mexico for the application of safeguards under the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America, which is reproduced in document INFCIRC/118, has been suspended pursuant to Article 23 of Mexico's agreement with the Agency for the application of safeguards in connection with that Treaty and the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons [1].
- 2. Suspension took effect from 14 September 1973, the date on which the latter agreement entered into force.
