REPORTS ON ASSISTANCE FURNISHED TO NON-NUCLEAR-WEAPON STATES

Note by the Director General

- 1. The Resident Representative of the United Arab Republic to the Agency has communicated to the Director General a copy of a paper circulated to the Conference of Non-Nuclear-Weapon States which was held by the United Nations at Geneva in September 1968, requesting that it be brought to the attention of all Members of the Agency for their information.

The paper in question, which was written by Dr. M.A. El-Guebeily, the Director of the Atomic Energy Establishment in the United Arab Republic, is entitled "Submission of Periodic Reports by Countries, to an International Agency, on the Nature and the Extent of Nuclear Technical Assistance and Fissionable Material Supplied by Them to Non-Nuclear-Weapon States for Peaceful Purposes", and was reproduced by the United Nations Secretariat under the symbol and number A/CONF.35/DOC.4.
