THE TEXT OF THE AGREEMENT OF 25 FEBRUARY 1975 BETWEEN THE AGENCY, THE GOVERNMENT OF MONACO AND THE OCEANOGRAPHIC INSTITUTE AT MONACO CONCERNING DEVELOPMENTAL STUDIES ON THE EFFECTS OF RADIOACTIVITY IN THE SEA

## Extensions of the Agreement

1. The agreement of 25 February 1975 between the Agency, the Government of the Principality of Monaco and the Oceanographic Institute at Monaco, concerning developmental studies on the effects of radioactivity in the sea provided for the project in question to continue for a period of six years ending on 31 December 1980.[1]

2. On 5 February 1981 the three parties agreed, in an exchange of letters, on a continuation of the project for six months ending on 30 June 1981.

3. On 1 June 1981 the three parties agreed, in an exchange of letters, on a further extension of the project for a period of three years ending on 30 June 1984, with the understanding that any party to the agreement may terminate it by giving six months' notice.
