LETTER OF 30 MAY 1985

"Sir,

"Further to my letter of 6 May 1985, circulated as INFCIRC/324 on 8 May 1985, I would like to state once more that the position of the Government of Israel was brought to your attention in my letter of 21 August 1984 reproduced in document GC(XXVIII)/720 of 30 August 1984.

"Whilst the above position of the Government of Israel is clearly on official record, it is noted that the communication of the Resident Representative of Iraq of 20 May 1985 (INFCIRC/325) makes no mention of the Government of Iraq's policy in the matter of attacks on nuclear facilities, which, in the light of recent and repeated events, remains a matter of ambiguity and conjecture.

"It is the earnest hope, however, of my Government that this matter be once and for all put behind us and, therefore, Israel will not engage in repetitious arguments which serve no practical purpose for the IAEA.

"I have the honour to request that this letter be circulated to all Member States."
