AMENDMENT OF ARTICLE VI.A.1 OF THE STATUTE

The depositary Government designated by the Statute, that of the United States of America, has informed the Agency that the amendment to Article VI.A.1 of the Statute which was approved by the General Conference on 27 September 1984^{1/} came into force on 28 December 1989. The amended sentence reads as follows:

"The outgoing Board of Governors shall designate for membership on the Board the ten members most advanced in the technology of atomic energy including the production of source materials, and the member most advanced in the technology of atomic energy including the production of source materials in each of the following areas in which none of the aforesaid ten is located:

- (1) North America
- (2) Latin America
- (3) Western Europe
- (4) Eastern Europe
- (5) Africa
- (6) Middle East and South Asia
- (7) South East Asia and the Pacific
- (8) Far East."
