AMENDMENT OF ARTICLE VI.A.3 OF THE STATUTE

The depositary Government designated by the Statute, that of the United States of America, has informed the Agency that the amendment to the first sentence of Article VI.A.3 of the Statute, which was approved by the General Conference on 4 October 1961 [1], came into force on 31 January 1963. The amended sentence reads as follows:

"The General Conference shall elect twelve members to membership on the Board of Governors, with due regard to equitable representation on the Board as a whole of the members in the areas listed in sub-paragraph A.1 of this article, so that the Board shall at all times include in this category three representatives of the area of Latin America, three representatives of the area of Africa and the Middle East and a representative of each of the remaining areas except North America."
