Supplementary Supply Agreement

As a sequel to the assistance which the Agency provided to the Government of Pakistan in connection with a research reactor project [1], a Supplementary Supply Agreement has been concluded between the Agency and the Governments of Pakistan and the United States of America. This Agreement entered into force on 30 September 1969, and the text [2] is reproduced herein for the information of all Members.

SUPPLEMENTARY SUPPLY AGREEMENT

SUPPLEMENTARY CONTRACT FOR THE TRANSFER TO PAKISTAN
OF ENRICHED URANIUM CONTAINED IN A FISSION CHAMBER

The International Atomic Energy Agency (hereinafter called the "Agency"), the Government of Pakistan (hereinafter called "Pakistan") and the United States Atomic Energy Commission (hereinafter called the "Commission"), acting on behalf of the Government of the United States of America, hereby agree as follows:

Section 1. In addition to the fuel material transferred pursuant to the Contract for the Transfer of Enriched Uranium signed in Vienna on 28 and 29 August, and 19 October 1967 [3], the Commission shall transfer to the Agency and the Agency shall accept from the Commission approximately 2 grams of uranium enriched to approximately 93% by weight in the isotope ^{235}U , contained in a fission chamber type WL 8073.

Section 2. The Agency shall transfer to Pakistan and Pakistan shall accept from the Agency the material described in Section 1.

Section 3. The terms and conditions of the Contract referred to in Section 1 shall apply, mutatis mutandis, to the transfer specified in Sections 1 and 2.

Section 4. This Supplementary Contract shall enter into force upon signature by or for the Director General of the Agency and by the authorized representatives of the Commission and Pakistan.
