## The Text of the Agreement of 28 July 1975 between Swaziland and the Agency for the Application of Safeguards in Connection with the Treaty on the Non Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons

## **Amended Protocol**

- 1. The text of the amended Protocol to the Agreement between the Kingdom of Swaziland and the International Atomic Energy Agency for the Application of Safeguards in Connection with the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons<sup>1</sup>, is reproduced in this document for the information of all Member States of the Agency.
- 2. Pursuant to Article II of the Protocol, the Protocol entered into force on 23 July 2010, upon signature by the representatives of Swaziland and the Agency.

## PROTOCOL

The Kingdom of Swaziland (hereinafter referred to as "Swaziland") and the International Atomic Energy Agency (hereinafter referred to as "the Agency") have agreed as follows:

- I. (1) Until such time as Swaziland
  - (a) has, in peaceful nuclear activities within its territory or under its jurisdiction or control anywhere, nuclear material in quantities exceeding the limits stated, for the type of material in question, in Article 36 of the Agreement between Swaziland and the Agency for the Application of Safeguards in Connection with the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"), or
  - (b) has taken the decision to construct or authorize construction of a facility, as defined in the Definitions,

the implementation of the provisions of Part II of the Agreement shall be held in abeyance, with the exception of Articles 32–38, 40, 48, 49, 59, 61, 67, 68, 70, 72-76, 82, 84–90, 94 and 95.

- (2) The information to be reported pursuant to paragraphs (a) and (b) of Article 33 of the Agreement may be consolidated and submitted in an annual report; similarly, an annual report shall be submitted, if applicable, with respect to the import and export of nuclear material described in paragraph (c) of Article 33.
- (3) In order to enable the timely conclusion of the Subsidiary Arrangements provided for in Article 38 of the Agreement, Swaziland shall:
  - (a) notify the Agency sufficiently in advance of its having nuclear material in peaceful nuclear activities within its territory or under its jurisdiction or control anywhere in quantities that exceed the limits, as referred to in section (1) hereof, or
  - (b) notify the Agency as soon as the decision to construct or to authorize construction of a facility has been taken,

whichever occurs first.

II. This Protocol shall replace the Protocol to the Agreement signed by Swaziland on 8 July 1975, which entered into force on 28 July 1975, and shall enter into force upon signature by the representatives of Swaziland and the Agency.
