THE TEXT OF THE AGREEMENT OF 20 AUGUST 1984 EXTENDING THE ASIAN REGIONAL CO-OPERATIVE PROJECT ON FOOD IRRADIATION

Second Extension Agreement

1. The text of the Second Agreement to Extend the Agreement of 23 May 1980 Establishing the Asian Regional Co-operative Project on Food Irradiation /1_/ within the framework of the Regional Co-operative Agreement for Research, Development and Training Related to Nuclear Science and Technology of 1972 /2_/, as extended in 1977 /3_/ and in 1982 /4_/, is reproduced herein for the information of all Members. The First Extension Agreement of 8 July 1983 /5_/ was due to expire on 27 August 1984.

2. Notifications of acceptance of the Second Extension Agreement in accordance with Article II, paragraph 1, were received by the Agency from the following Governments on the dates indicated below:

SECOND AGREEMENT
TO EXTEND THE AGREEMENT ESTABLISHING
THE ASIAN REGIONAL CO-OPERATIVE PROJECT
ON FOOD IRRADIATION

WHEREAS the Agreement of 1980 Establishing the Asian Regional Co-operation Project on Food Irradiation (hereinafter referred to as “the Regional Food Irradiation Agreement”) within the framework of the Regional Co-operative Agreement for Research, Development and Training Related to Nuclear Science and Technology (hereinafter referred to as “the Regional Co-operative Agreement”) was first extended for a period of one year with effect from 28 August 1983, pursuant to the Extension Agreement of 8 July 1983;

WHEREAS the Regional Food Irradiation Agreement is due to expire on 27 August 1984; and

WHEREAS the Governments Parties to the Regional Food Irradiation Agreement (hereinafter referred to as “the Governments”) and the International Atomic Energy Agency (hereinafter referred to as “the Agency”) desire to extend the Agreement for another period of three years in view of its usefulness in furthering co-ordinated research and co-operative activities on food irradiation in the participating countries, with particular regard to the transfer of technology to relevant industries;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governments and the Agency hereby agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

Extension of the Regional Food Irradiation Agreement

The Regional Food Irradiation Agreement shall continue in force for a further period of three years with effect from 28 August 1984. Unless otherwise agree, all arrangements made in implementation of the Agreement shall continue in force during the extended period.

ARTICLE II

Entry into force

1. Any Government Party to the Regional Food Irradiation Agreement or Regional Co-operative Agreement may become a Party to this Second Extension Agreement by notifying its acceptance thereof to the Director General of the Agency.

2. This Second Extension Agreement shall enter into force on the date on which the Director General of the Agency has received notifications of acceptance from one Donor Government and two Participating Governments. With respect to each Government accepting the Agreement thereafter, it shall enter into force on the date of receipt by the Director General of the Agency of the notification of such acceptance.
