COMMUNICATION DATED 5 DECEMBER 1994 RECEIVED FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA (SERBIA AND MONTENEGRO)

The text of the attached letter, dated 5 December 1994, from the Permanent Mission of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia (Serbia and Montenegro) is being brought to the attention of Member States of the Agency, at the request of the Permanent Mission.

LETTER FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA (SERBIA AND MONTENEGRO) TO THE DIERCTOR GENERAL, DATED 5 DECEMBER 1994

Sir,

I have the honour to refer to the Agency's Proposed Programme of Technical Cooperation for 1995-96 doc. GOV/2768/Add.1. We note with regret that FR of Yugoslavia is not among the countries whose projects are proposed for financing under the Agency's 1995-96 Technical Co-operation Programme. May I remind that requests from Yugoslavia for consideration under the 1995-96 TC Programme were duly submitted and noted by the Secretariat. We are aware of the limitations imposed under UN Security Council Resolution 757. Nevertheless, the problem could have been solved, as was done in the case of some other countries, by inclusion of the appropriate remark which would reflect the fact that the implementation of the proposed projects would be in accordance with the relevant Security Council resolutions. This unreasonable stand taken by the Agency's Secretariat prevents the FR of Yugoslavia from exercising the rights deriving from its membership in the Agency.

The situation created puts the FR of Yugoslavia in the position to reconsider its intention to continue cooperation with the IAEA including the fulfilment of its commitments under the relevant treaties.

I would be grateful, Mr. Director General, if you would bring this letter to the attention of Member States of the IAEA.
