IAEA STATUTE: AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES VI AND XIV

I am pleased to inform you that the United Kingdom has now completed the legal process for United Kingdom acceptance of the amendments to Articles VI and XIV of the IAEA Statute, agreed by the General Conference on 1 October 1999. The Instrument of Notification of Acceptance, signed by the Foreign Secretary, Robin Cook, on 20 November 2000 has been deposited with the US Government as the depository Government.
