I have the honour to inform you that France has completed the constitutional procedures required for the approval of the amendments to Articles VI and XIV of the IAEA's Statute adopted in Vienna on 1 October 1999. The instrument of acceptance, signed by the Minister of Foreign Affairs, was deposited on 2 May 2001 with the Government of the United States of America, the depositary State, which acknowledged receipt thereof on the same day.
