The Ambassador of the Islamic Republic of Iran, while referring to the State of Israel in the meetings of the Board of Governors, does not use Israel's official name but rather, terms which are highly inappropriate. This deplorable practice is unacceptable, and should not be condoned.

My Government would appreciate, Mr. Chairman, your call on all representatives addressing the Board to refer to all Member States without any exception only by their official name.

I kindly request this letter to be circulated to all members of the Board of Governors and other member States of the Agency, as well as an INFCIRC document.
