The Permanent Mission of Ukraine to the International Organizations in Vienna presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency and has the honour to inform the following.

After cruise missiles were recorded flying at an altitude of approximately 100-200 meters directly above Unit № 1 of the South Ukraine NPP on 16 April 2022, similar cases were recorded over the Khmelnytsky NPP (25 April 2022) and Zaporizhzhia NPP (26 April 2022).

The frequency and intensity of the fire attacks clearly show that the Russian military forces are targeting the nuclear power plants and paving the trajectory of missiles over the nuclear power plants. This may indicate Russia's intentions regarding the deliberate destruction of nuclear facilities in Ukraine.

The Permanent Mission of Ukraine requests the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency to promptly circulate this Note Verbale as Information Circular to all IAEA Member States.

The Permanent Mission of Ukraine to the International Organizations in Vienna avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the International Atomic Energy Agency the assurances of its highest consideration.
