The Permanent Mission of the Russian Federation to the International Organizations in Vienna presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency and has the honor to inform about the situation at the Zaporozhskaya NPP (ZNPP) as of 31 May 2023.

NPP personnel perform their duties in accordance with the work schedule established at the facility. Its number is sufficient to ensure the safe and sustainable operation of the ZNPP. The plant employees observe the technological discipline provided for by the operational and organizational and administrative documentation. The configuration of systems and elements important for plant safety is in line with the design and regulatory requirements for the current state of power units.

Power units No. 1 and No. 3 are under scheduled maintenance; No. 2, No. 4, No. 6 are in a cold shutdown state; No. 5 is in a hot shutdown state.

Power supply for the plant's own needs is carried out through the high-voltage line 750 kV "Dneprovskaya". In case of loss of external power supply, the fuel supply for diesel generator sets is sufficient for more than 20 days of plant operation.

The radiation background at the ZNPP site and beyond does not exceed the established limits.

During the period from May 19 to May 29, 105 aircrafts launched by Ukraine with the aim of attacks and provocations against the plant were detected and suppressed.
