Dr. Untung Suseno Sutarjo, M. Kes, is the General Secretary of the Republic of Indonesia's Ministry of Health. He is responsible for coordinating with and providing administrative support to all organizational units within the Ministry of Health. He served as a Special Advisor to the Minister of Health on Financing and Community Empowerment from 2011-2012.

Dr. Sutarjo graduated from the Faculty of Medicine, University of Indonesia in 1983 and earned a Master's degree in Public Health from the University of Gajah Mada in 1988. Upon his graduation, he assumed a position as the Supporting Director at Persahabatan Hospital in Jakarta in 2001.

Since joining the Ministry of Health in 2004, he has held several key management positions, namely, Head of the Development and Empowerment of Health Human Resources (2012-2014), Head of the Planning and Budget Bureau (2009-2011), Head of Health Development Studies Center (2008-2009), Director of Occupational Health Development (2006-2008), Head of the Health Workers Empowerment Center (2005-2006), and Director of Medical and Dental Service (2004-2005).
